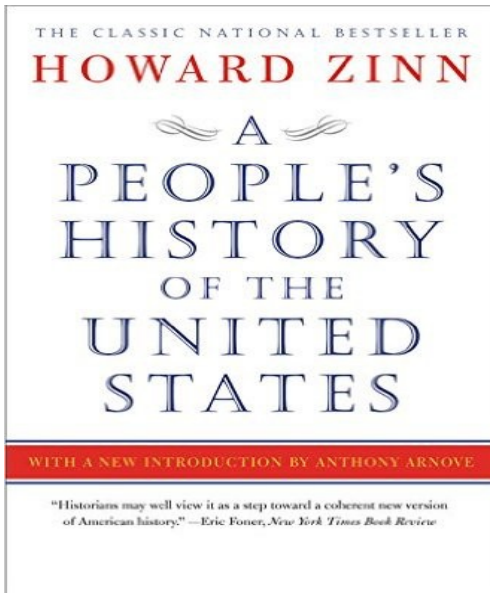


Boulder Great Books Discussion Group
