Ted Kooser was born in Ames, Iowa in 1939. He studied at Iowa State University and has an MA in English from the University of Nebraska. His writing is known for its clarity, precision and accessibility. He worked for many years in the life insurance business, retiring in 1999 as a vice president. He is the author of ten collections of poetry including Winter Morning Walks: One Hundred Postcards to Jim Harrison, Weather Central, and Flying at Night. His fiction and non-fiction books include The Poetry Home Repair Manual (2005); Braided Creek: A Conversation in Poetry; and Local Wonders: Seasons in the Bohemian Alps which won the Nebraska Book Award.

His honors include two NEA fellowships in poetry, a Pushcart Prize, the Stanley Kunitz Prize from Columbia University, and the Pulitzer Prize for poetry. In 2004 Kooser was appointed thirteenth Poet Laureate of the U.S. He served the Library of Congress's in that position for two years. He is currently the Presidential Professor of English at The University of Nebraska, Lincoln. He and his wife Kathleen Rutledge, retired editor of the Lincoln Journal Star, live near the village of Garland, Nebraska.




